International students applying who will enter the United States on an F-1 visa must deposit US \$4,000. This deposit is required of all new F-1 visa holders before issuance of the Form I-20, including those already in the United States. The deposit must be sent **after** the notification of acceptance. The deposit belongs to the student and may be used towards his/her educational expenses. Contact the institution's Admissions Office if a refund becomes necessary.

An additional U.S. \$2,000 per year should be added to the above estimates for each dependent. All fees are subject to change without notice.

Health Insurance

Full-time students must either enroll in a CES school Health Plan or provide verification of adequate insurance coverage. The approximate cost of this insurance is U.S. \$400 for each year.
